

### Licence Terms of Historia scholastica Journal

# I. Introductory statement

1. By sending a manuscript (i. e. text including photographs, graphs or charts; hereafter reffered as the "work") to the editorial office of Historia scholastica Journal, the author expresses his or her interest to publish his or her work and therefore provides it voluntarily to publishers of Historia scholastica Journal (hereafter reffered as the "Journal") — the National Pedagogical Museum and Library of J. A. Comenius and Technical University of Liberec (hereafter reffered as the "Publishers").

### II. Use of a work

- 1. In case of publishing the manuscript both in electronic or printed versions the author provides licence to reproduce his or her work to Publishers of the Journal permanently and free of charge.
- 2. The following declaration has to be attached to the text sent to the editorial office: I declare that the text has not been offered to any other journal for publication and I agree that in case of publication of the text in the Historia scholastica Journal I provide to the National Pedagogical Museum and Library of J. A. Comenius and Technical University of Liberec a licence to reproduce the text.
- 3. Historia scholastica is an Open Access journal under Creative Commons licence CC BY-NC-ND 4.0 (Attribution Non Commercial No Derivatives).

#### III. Fees

- 1. Publishing of the manuscripts is free of charge, no fees are charged for the manuscript submission, processing and publication.
- 2. Costs of realization of the Journal both in electronic and printed versions are covered by the Publishers, who give to the author 1 copy of the Journal, in which will be published author's work.

### IV. Author's Consent to the processing of personal data

1. Author, who sent his or her work to the editorial office, agrees with processing of personal data in a scope — name, surname, workplace, address and e-mail. These personal data are published both in electronic and printed versions of the Journal.

## V. Final statement

1. Licence Terms of the Journal are governed by the provisions of the Czech law, in particular the Copyright Act and the Civil Code as amended.
